

## **Exploring nature - items that tell a story**

This week we're going to draw from observation focusing on a few found objects.

An understanding of an environment is often about the objects we see along the way. Our environment and landscape may be very beautiful - but there is also evidence of pollution and industry all around. If you were to take a short walk down to the sea for instance, you will see plastic litter, fishing net and other detritus - evidence of a global plastic pollution problem. These objects are affected by natural processes and become mixed in with nature - and so inevitably tell a story about the environment. Select a few objects to draw - they could be objects in your home that you've found, or perhaps things you've collected, you could even take a short walk and you might find some problematic objects that highlight pollution and litter. Just as long as your items tell some kind of a story
