Pedas Treasurers Report 2021

These accounts, aggregated with GUS, will be presented to the Charity Commission as part of the report we have to submit before October each year. They have been prepared by a qualified person, but do not need to be audited.

According to the requirements of CC, income to our Charity has to be called 'Donations', so sales at our Exhibitions and income from meetings are combined in these Accounts.

The actual amounts are;

Sales at Exhibitions; £6564 Meeting income; 669 Total 7233

During 2021 we were lucky to receive a bequest of £500 from Yvonne Bottwood, who was a member for many years - some of our current members will remember her.

The Trustees agreed that the best use of this money was to purchase a Sound System, which has already proved very helpful at demos and social events. Thanks to David Roberts for sourcing it and bringing it to events. The cost was £440.

Another cost in 2021 was £640 for legal expenses for becoming a Charity.

Our Exhibitions in 2021 were all successful financially, although we paid £400 to DAW in 2019, which happened in 2021. I have laid out the results from the last three years.
